Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Burr Oak Regional Water District Water Expansion Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Burr Oak Regional Water District, located at 23554 Jenkins Dam Road, Glouster, OH 45732. Funding for this project will be used for an expansion project to address an area in Morgan County with contaminated and inadequate water supplies. The project will include approximately 100,000 feet of 6" through 2" waterlines including hydrants, valves, water services and other appurtenances. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the area is known to have limited water supply from private wells, cisterns, and springs that have also shown to have bacterial contamination. BORWD will expand waterlines off the Bishopville system to allow clean drinking water into areas not currently served.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
