HEAT Updates:

- HEAT Chair Troy Balderson, RSC Chair August Pfluger, and Vice Chair Randy Weber hosted a roundtable discussion with stakeholders across various sectors of the energy industry to foster collaboration and discuss agenda priorities for unleashing American energy.

Member Highlights:

• The House passed **RSC Chairman Pfluger's** *Protecting American Energy Production Act*, which would prohibit any federal moratorium on the use of hydraulic fracturing.



- The House passed **Chairman Bruce Westerman's** *Fix Our Forests Act*, which would implement crucial reforms to facilitate active forest management and rein in weaponization of statutes such as NEPA and the ESA.
- HEAT Chairman Troy Balderson and RSC Chairman Pfluger introduced a resolution recognizing the benefits of natural gas to the United States economy and environment and recognizing natural gas as an affordable and "green" energy.
- HEAT Chairman Troy Balderson introduced the <u>GRID Power Act</u> along with Senators John Hoeven and Todd Young. The bill would enable grid operators to fast-track consideration of power generation projects that improve the reliability of the electric grid.
- **Rep. Clay Higgins** introduced H.R. 513 the <u>Offshore Lands Authorities Act</u> to revoke the Biden administration's radical offshore leasing ban and further reform the offshore leasing withdrawal process to prevent such administrative abuse against American energy production.
- RSC Chairman Pfluger, along with Rep. Jodey Arrington and Sen. Hoeven, introduced a Congressional Review Act (CRA) <u>resolution</u> to repeal the EPA's methane fee.
 - Chairman Pfluger and Sen. Cruz also introduced the <u>Natural Gas Tax</u> <u>Repeal Act</u> to repeal the natural gas tax from the Clean Air Act.

- **Rep. Mike Carey**, HEAT's Vice Chair in the 118th Congress, reintroduced H.R. 662 the *Promoting Domestic Energy Production Act* to restore the Intangible Drilling Costs (IDC) deduction for American energy production. The bill would fix a provision within the Inflation Reduction Act that unfairly penalizes America's energy producers.
- **Rep. Harriet Hageman** introduced <u>legislation</u> to streamline applications for coal leasing, as well as <u>additional bills</u> to rein in onerous regulations on oil, gas, coal, and mineral production.
- **Rep. Gary Palmer** introduced a CRA <u>resolution</u> to overturn the Biden administration's energy conservation standards for water heaters.
- Rep. Stephanie Bice introduced a CRA <u>resolution</u> to overturn the Biden administration's energy conservation standards for walk-in coolers and freezers.
- **Rep. Neal Dunn** introduced a CRA <u>resolution</u> to overturn the Biden administration's onerous refrigerator regulations.
- **Rep. Mike Flood** introduced the *Ending Green Giveaways Act*, which would rescind wasteful Inflation Reduction Act funding for "environmental justice and climate justice" grants.
