Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Pickerington Intersection Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive this funding is the City of Pickerington, located at 100 Lockville Road, Pickerington, OH 43147. The funding would be used to replace the existing 4-legged skewed Center/Milnor/Meadows intersection with a modern roundabout that also incorporates sidewalks and improves sight distance. The intersection is currently a non-standard K-type, skewed four-leg configuration, whereby intersection approaches create sight distance limitations and irregular turning paths leading to driver uncertainty and confusion, resulting in a significant crash history. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase safety at a crash-prone intersection and provide better access to the City of Pickerington's new downtown Elevate District, which is creating significant new economic development in the City.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
