Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Village of Crooksville Waterline Replacement and Extension Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Crooksville, located at 98 S. Buckeye St. Crooksville, OH 43731. The funding would go towards the replacement of two water booster pump stations that have exceeded their useful life. Both stations will be replaced with new above-grade pre-fabricated pump stations. The project also includes replacement and upgrade of 4,200 feet of undersized and outdated waterlines and will also extend 9,100 feet of new waterline to serve approximately 15 new customers. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will allow the Village to maintain water quality, provide clean water, protect the public health, and ensure long-term regulatory compliance.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
